

## Westminster Larger Catechism

### **Q. 103. Which is the first commandment?**

A. The first commandment is, *Thou shall have no other gods before me.*

### **Q. 104. What are the duties required in the first commandment?**

A. The duties required in the first commandment are, the knowing and acknowledging of God to be the only true God, and our God; and to worship and glorify him accordingly, by thinking, meditating, remembering, highly esteeming, honoring, adoring, choosing, loving, desiring, fearing of him; believing him; trusting hoping, delighting, rejoicing in him; being zealous for him; calling upon him, giving all praise and thanks, and yielding all obedience and submission to him with the whole man; being careful in all things to please him, and sorrowful when in any thing he is offended; and walking humbly with him.

The Collect

Psalms 78:1-8

- (1) Give ear, O my people, to my teaching; incline your ears to the words of my mouth! (2) I will open my mouth in a parable; I will utter dark sayings from of old,**
- (3) things that we have heard and known, that our fathers have told us.
- (4) We will not hide them from their children, but tell to the coming generation the glorious deeds of the LORD, and his might, and the wonders that he has done.**
- (5) He established a testimony in Jacob and appointed a law in Israel, which he commanded our fathers to teach to their children,
- (6) that the next generation might know them, the children yet unborn, and arise and tell them to their children,**
